Position: Chief Medical Officer

We are seeking a dynamic **Chief Medical Officer** to join our team. Job Summary

The Chief Medical Officer (CMO) is a key partner in collaboration with the CEO and COO – the third member of the KHS Senior Executive Team (CEO; COO and CMO) - engaged in defining the overall business strategy and direction of the organization. In addition, this position leads the overall clinical vision for the organization and provides clinical support to the Clinical Service Lines.

This position provides primary care medical oversight, expertise and leadership to ensure the delivery of affordable quality healthcare services. Responsibilities also include the strategy, development and implementation of innovative clinical programs that include collaboration with strategic business partners.

The KHS Clinics are:

- KHS- Bonners Ferry Clinic
- KHS- Sandpoint Clinic
- KHS –Sandpoint Pediatrics Clinic
- KHS – VA Clinic
- KHS- Priest River Clinic

The CMO maintains a contemporary knowledge of primary care clinical practice. Requires function as a staff physician (Family Medicine, Internal Medicine or Pediatrician) at a KHS Clinic Site – minimum of .1 FTE (10 clinical hours per week).

Working with the CEO, promulgates and enforces all rules and regulations for the proper conduct of KHS and its purposes made by and under the authority of the Board of Directors. Formulates, establishes and enforces such additional policies, procedures, rules and regulations as may be necessary to provide for the proper provision of health care services.
